AQHA RULES APPLY to AQHA CLASSES Please acquaint yourself with the current AQHA Rules. Every exhibitor showing MUST PRESENT A CURRENT AQHA CARD, or purchase one at the show office prior to showing. If you cannot produce your current membership card you will need to purchase one at the show, this includes Amateur & Youth. These fees are non-refundable. DUAL MEMBERSHIPS for class participation are not accepted.

STALLIONS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN NOVICE or YOUTH CLASSES.

ENTRIES are due by June 30th to avoid late fee and should be accompanied by a signed check. If you have entered a class improperly, you will be billed.

FAXES are considered an official entry and as such you are responsible for all charges noted. **If you are a no-show, you will be billed** & AQHA will be notified if necessary. Faxes must be complete with name & address.

Fax deadline June 30th.

FUTURITY ENTRIES MAY NOT BE FAXED.

HORSE REGISTRATION PAPERS & AQHA MEMBERSHIP

CARDS must be inspected by show secretary before numbers are issued. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Copies are OK. Signed transfers **ARE NOT** acceptable.

ROM Papers from AQHA must be submitted for acceptance in a Performance Halter class.

CATTLE ENTRIES must be received NO LATER than June 30th or CLASS MAY BE CANCELED. **Draws for all cattle classes will be done at the close of pre-entries. Post entries are added to the end of the draw.**

ADDS & SCRATCHES must be made in the office. Please make any changes at least 2 classes ahead. Exhibitors showing in a class not properly entered will be charged double. Gate scratches will NOT be refunded.

ARRIVAL TIME - Not before Wednesday July 6th.

STALLS - reserve stalls by June 30th with the enclosed reservation form. RV reservations will go on the same form. Please send separate form & check for stalls, bedding & Camping reservation. Bedding does not come with stalls. ORDER BEDDING with stall reservations or by June 30th. Shavings, but not feed, will be available on the show grounds during the show.

***WALK/JOG 11 and under** - Exhibitor may NEVER have shown in a loping class at a VQHA show.

❖GREEN HORSE: Horses that have not earned more than 10 AQHA points in relevant events prior to January 1, 2011 or won more than \$1,000 in the respective event.

EVERY HORSE on show grounds must be issued a back number and is subject to Haul-In or Stall fee. No temporary pens or tying horses to trailers overnight or to trees at any time.

NO TRAILER PARKING IN OR NEXT TO BARN AREA. Trailers may be dropped off in the upper parking area by the barns. **DRY CAMPING** (no water / no power) is available. \$10 per night. Full Hooks are available at **Pechanga RV Resort – 1.877.997.8386 or 951.587.0484**

SHOW MANAGEMENT RIGHTS: VQHA reserves the right to move & combine classes. Show Management reserves the right to interpret all questions & conditions in regard to or rising out of an incident of the show without further claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered by these rules & regulations shall be decided by the show management & their decision shall be final. Any monies put up by exhibitors as class incentive is not endorsed by nor the responsibility of VQHA, AQHA, NRCHA, SCRCHA or the show staff.

RETURNED CHECK FEE - \$50. Returned checks must be redeemed with a money order, cashiers' check or cash including the \$50 returned check fee, within 5 days of notification or we will notify AQHA.

DOGS are welcome, but MUST BE in the control of a competent person at all times. Dogs creating a problem or disturbance will be asked to leave and get no biscuits. Dogs making their show home in a horse stall who aren't sharing with a horse will be charged stall fees. Cats, chickens and rabbits – no charge.
